If you would like to arrange a direct cremation, a casket is not required, an alternative container can be used. Alternative containers encase the remains and are used to protect the remains during transportation and facilitate safe handling procedures these containers can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of heavy cardboard. These charges are based upon the death occurring within the confines and at a local hospital of Wayne County, Michigan.
